- Also Helpful: these opportunities are very helpful
- Other Opportunities: not essential, but can be helpful if someone has additional time

### **HIGHEST PRIORITY**

### **Substitute Teacher**

 Substitute teachers for classes (Grammar and Logic School) at OHCS; must complete application, background check, interview with one of the Heads of School, and complete substitute training.

### **Class Parent**

- On-call volunteer for special in-class projects or events, or assist with teacher needs
- Classroom support at home (laminating, cutting, projects, etc.)
- Class party coordinator

# **Hot Lunch Fridays**

• Every full Friday is a Hot lunch optional day. We need 3-4 volunteers to assist with food order pickups, plate/bag food and serving food.

#### **Events**

Event help may include tasks such as: planning team, supply acquisition, food preparation, event setup, staffing at the event, event cleanup

## **Facility Care**

- Assist with various facility maintenance tasks within your skill set throughout the school year; projects may include: carpentry, handyman jobs, plumbing, cleaning air purifier filters, general cleaning, etc. times vary.
- Kitchen Cleanup: On Fridays between 1:30-3:00, a general cleaning of the kitchen.
- Library Help: On Fridays between 1:30-3:00, reshelving books and general straightening of the Library/Gathering Room
- Facility Beautification: Flower pots, landscape beds in parking lot, landscape projects, pressure washing, etc.

## Laundry

At home:

 Take home dirty cleaning rags and art smocks weekly to wash, fold, and return to OHCS - approximately 2 hours weekly.

# **Shopping**

At stores (OHCS will reimburse expenses with receipt submission, unless volunteer is donating supplies):

- Costco shopping: Purchase supplies such as half & half, tissues, paper towels, office supplies, hot lunch supplies, etc. throughout the year, as requested
- Event shopping: shop for needed items at stores prior to the event
- Teacher workroom stock: snacks, coffee pods, etc.

#### Audio/Visual

At OHCS/events/home:

• Create, set up, and tear down sound systems, playlists, etc.

## Field Trip Driver/Chaperone

• Serve as field trip/driver chaperone for your child's class or other classes as needed.

# **Summer Uniform Swap**

At OHCS:

- Collect uniform donations and give families tally of credit (5 items for 5 items)
- Inventory and clothing evaluation approximately 2 hour commitment/collection event

At Uniform Swap:

- Assist with setup of Uniform Swap
- Cashiers and shopping assistants 2 hours during event
- Assist with event clean-up approximately 1 hour

### **OTHER OPPORTUNITIES**

## **Cleaning**

 Kitchen: Clear expired, unmarked items out of staff refrigerator and freezer, wipe down shelves - during school hours, every other month

## **Back-Up Custodian**

 Serve as back-up custodian after school hours when the regularly scheduled custodian is unavailable - occasional evenings/weekends, approximately 3 hours per day when needed

# Library

At home:

• Repair books, cover books - as needed throughout school year

# **Community Building**

At home/events:

- Plan and host fellowship events, such as: Men's BBQ, Women's Brunch, Park Meet-Ups, etc.
- Coordinate Moms in Prayer times

# **Craft Projects**

At home:

- Assist with various craft projects, such as: prepping classroom projects, event decorations, teacher appreciation week crafts
- Cutting projects recurring need throughout the year

## **Gardening**

• Responsible for providing seasonal plants in two planters 4x a year. (Beginning of September, December, and April.)

## **Grade Level Gatherings**

At home/non-OHCS location:

 Host a grade level gathering to allow OHCS students and families to spend time together - times vary

### In a Pinch

At home/OHCS:

- Be available for last-minute volunteer needs that may arise, helping if possible in these "in a pinch" moments
- Run errands for the school to pick up items such as medals, print shop items, etc.
